Safety:

You are responsible for reviewing and understanding the safety protocols in place during Women in the Woods. The Women in the Woods Camper Manual is available on the Camp Ma-He-Tu website and will be emailed to participants prior to the session start.

You should understand the following before your arrival at camp:

- Waterfront Procedures, including Swim Testing
- Emergency Signals
- Camp Boundaries
- Restricted Activity Areas
- Wildlife Safety
- Child Supervision
- Health Services

Supervision (for adults accompanying children under 18 years old):

The New York State Department of Health **requires** that **an adult supervise children 16 years of age and under at ALL** times at camp.

There will be many opportunities during Women in the Woods where Ma-He-Tu staff can supervise your child/children, depending on the activity offerings. You, or an adult you appoint, must personally check the child/children in with the Ma-He-Tu staff member in charge of the activity and meet that child at the end of the designated activity or time period.

- If your child is under six years of age, we ask that you, or someone you appoint, stay on camp grounds and let the staff member know where to reach you while your child is under her supervision.
- If your child is NOT participating in a counselor-run activity, she must be participating in an activity with you or with an adult you designate. No children should be left alone without supervision.

You are responsible for reviewing the supervision and safety rules with your child/children.
